




Chaplain's Corner





As an example, the basic training certificate can be earned in five or six hours of online work. There is no cost involved. You can study at your leisure: start/stop anytime (your work is always saved). Whenever you are awarded a certificate, let me know so we can acknowledge your achievements.

Washington St. The VSO serves as a liaison for the veteran for all veteran VA benefits and will assist with sign up, inquiries, appeals, etc. Appointments are on a first come first-serve basis; or you can schedule them. The VSO that is at the VAC office is not an employee of the IDVA; the VSO is employed by the VAC of Ogle County and paid from VAC funds.

If you need emergency or urgent care, and are-enrolled through the Madison VA hospital, call the VA triage line at 888-598-7793. Follow their recommendations for treatment. If they recommend that you go to an ER, go to the ER. If you are prescribed medication, go to a pharmacy and get them filled. You will have to pay for this out of pocket. Then contact Community Care in Madison at 888-478-8321, x 14431. Tell them about your ER visit and prescriptions. Fax a copy of your receipt to the Attention of Tom C. at 608-830-6653. It will take a while, but if approved, you will be reimbursed for your prescriptions.


